## Gas Interval Usage in EDI

Please note that we now have the option to provide Interval Usage in EDI for Gas customers who have an AMI meter. If you do not wish to receive this information, no changes are necessary on your part.

If you wish to receive this information, you may enroll new customers or make changes to existing customers using the REFIU segment of the 814E and 814C transactions. 814E sent requesting the Interval Usage for customers who do not have an AMI meter will be accepted with a warning indicating the customer does not have an AMI meter.
