Con Edison, together with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) and the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), is conducting an environmental investigation program on former Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) sites throughout the City. Manufactured gas plants were operated between the 1800s and mid-1900s, before the development of natural gas systems, to convert coal and oil into gas for heating, lighting and cooking.

At this public meeting Con Edison will be presenting the findings from the Remedial Investigation Report (RI) and discussing next steps in the remedial planning process for Purdy Street, a former Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) site. This site is currently occupied by St. Raymond High School for Boys.
