Preparing for an Outage:

- I have emergency services' phone numbers and emergency contact persons' phone numbers handy.
- I have a battery-operated radio, a flashlight and batteries within easy reach.
- I have canned food, a manual can opener and bottled water on hand.
- Since cordless phones won't work without electricity, I have a corded landline telephone or a cellular phone as backup.
- I have a backup generator, and I have been properly instructed on its operation.
- I have conducted an emergency drill in my home.
- I have another way to heat or cool my living space during extremely hot or cold weather.
- I have an electrically operated garage door, and I know how to open it manually.
- I have an electrically operated well pump, and I have filled a tub and plenty of extra containers with water.
