is seeking to obtain energy efficiency ratings from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) that will follow from the results of certain data regarding energy consumption (“Data”) within the Building. Owner seeks to obtain and report this Data either by itself or by one of its authorized officer, employee, or agents acting on its behalf (each, a “Representative” and collectively, “Representatives”) via the EPA’s ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager tool (“Portfolio Manager”). To accomplish this, Rockland Electric Company (“RECO”) requires Customer’s consent before it will release Customer’s Data to Owner for Owner or its Representatives to enter and report such Data into Portfolio Manager. Customer’s signature on this Customer Consent to Data Release for RECO Customers (“Consent Agreement”) provides RECO with the authorization to release Customer’s Data to Owner and its Representatives so that it may be submitted in the aforementioned manner.

Part II - Customer Consent and Authorization of Data Disclosure

A. Authorization – Customer hereby consents, authorizes, and provides permission (“Authorization”) for the following:

- (i) RECO to release to Owner up to [24] months of historical electricity usage data at least once for the duration of this Consent Agreement;
- (ii) RECO to electronically transfer Data to Owner, Owner's Representatives, and Portfolio Manager for the exclusive purpose of reporting, submitting, and uploading the Data into Portfolio Manager to assist in the benchmarking of the Building's energy and water consumption;
- (iii) The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“Board” or “BPU”), Board staff (“Board Staff”), and BPU representatives to access and review Data submitted to Portfolio Manager only for the purpose of building benchmarking, identifying energy efficiency projects, and energy management; and
- (iv) Owner, its Representatives, and RECO to access Customer's Data through Portfolio Manager.

B. Term – Customer's Authorization shall commence on the Execution Date of this Consent Agreement and shall terminate on the earliest of:

- (i) the date on which Customer vacates the Address;
- (ii) the date on which Customer rescinds this Consent Agreement by submitting a written notice of rescission to Owner and to RECO; or
- (iii) the date on which the Owner sells or demolishes the Building.

Part III. – Customer Release

Customer hereby declares that he/she/they are duly authorized to execute this Consent Agreement. Customer further certifies and affirms that Owner possesses the authority to act on Customer's behalf to request, from time to time, the disclosure and transmission from RECO to Portfolio Manager of energy usage associated with Customer at the Address, with respect to the Authorization above.

Customer holds harmless and indemnifies Utility, the BPU, and BPU Staff from any liability, claims, demands, causes of action, damages, or expenses resulting from: (i) any release of information of data to EPA for the national energy performance benchmarking program pursuant to this Consent Agreement; (ii) the unauthorized use of this Data by EPA; and (iii) any actions EPA takes with respect to such Data.

Customer certifies that all information contained in this Consent Agreement is true, accurate, complete, and correct.
