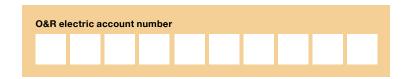
 Rebates are offered to individually metered residential New York Orange & Rockland electric and/or gas customers regardless of their energy supplier. If you are applying for rebates for more than one address, you must use a separate application for each.

- 2. Rebate applications must be completed, signed, and mailed with a copy of the AHRI certificate(s) or manufacturer's specification sheet(s) and a paid invoice from your contractor indicating the equipment type, make, model, price, serial number, and the date of purchase. Failure to complete this application in full may delay or disqualify your rebate. Applications must be received within 90 days of equipment installation. O&R shall not be responsible for lost, late, illegible, or misdirected mail. The most current version of this application supersedes all previous versions.
- 3. Equipment must be purchased and installed by December 31, 2021, to be eligible.
- Customer is not eligible to receive financial incentives for the same eligible equipment from both NYSERDA and another electric or gas utility company.
- 5. Eligible equipment must be installed by meeting all New York State and local municipality requirements and such equipment must meet the efficiency level set forth within the rebate application. The eligible high-efficiency equipment must be installed in accordance with all applicable codes and standards, including the proper sizing of high-efficiency equipment.
- 6. All work to be performed by or on behalf of a customer applying for the rebate must be in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules and regulations (including laws requiring the employment of licensed persons to perform such work), and all applicable O&R requirements for electric and gas service.
- 7. O&R may conduct a final inspection after all work has been completed and all necessary documentation has been received to determine whether rebates are payable. If O&R determines that you are eligible for the rebate, please allow nine weeks after inspection or receipt of documentation for payment of the rebate. Rebates will be paid by check directly to the O&R account holder.

- 8. Customer agrees and consents to O&R providing customer information, including but not limited to customer name, account number, electric/gas consumption data, and electric/gas energy savings to its third-party evaluation contractor for program evaluation purposes. The evaluation contractor is obligated to O&R to keep the customer information confidential. This information may also be provided by O&R to the New York State Public Service Commission. This information will be aggregated with information about other O&R customers.
- 9. Indemnification Customer shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless O&R and its officers, directors, employees, agents, servants and assigns from and against any and all losses, claims, demands and/ or liability for damage to property, injury or death of any person, or any other liability incurred by O&R, including all expenses, legal or otherwise, arising out of or related to the equipment or installation, except to the extent attributable to the negligence of O&R. In no event shall O&R's liability to customer exceed the rebate amounts.
- 10. Limited Scope Review The scope of review by O&R and the vendor and their inspector of the installation of the equipment is solely to determine whether rebates are payable. It does not include any safety or code review, and should not be relied upon as one.
- Customer shall be responsible for all taxes that may be imposed with respect to the rebate offer.
- 12. O&R does not endorse, guarantee, or warrant any particular contractor, manufacturer or product installation. O&R does not make any representation of any kind regarding the results to be achieved by the equipment or the adequacy or safety of such equipment.
- 13. Eligibility for the electric and gas rebates shall be determined by O&R, at its sole discretion. O&R has no obligation to notify the customer in the event O&R determines the customer is not eligible for a rebate.
